**Uganda RWI Announcement No.6 –  
Radiation Inspection Criteria Addition for Japan**

Dear Stakeholder,

Thank you for your continued support of the used vehicle pathway.

The Uganda National Bureau of Standards (UNBS) has announced the recommencement of the Used Vehicle Roadworthiness Inspection (RWI) from the 9<sup>th</sup> May 2011.

With the recent effects of the Fukushima nuclear power plants, the Ugandan government has added Radiation Inspections to the criteria.

Radiation level inspections to IAEA standards shall be undertaken on all Fukushima registered vehicles and all vehicles inspected in the following areas; Yamagata, Miyagi, Ibaragi, Tochiji, Saitama and Gunma.

Radiation inspections can also be undertaken at the following sites; Chiba, Kanagawa, Aichi, Osaka and Hyogo. Note that a random selection of vehicles will be tested at these sites to ensure safety.

There is no additional fee for the radiation level inspections, undertaken at the time of RWI.

To avoid any regulated penalty fees and inspection upon arrival, please ensure that all used vehicles exported to Uganda are inspected by JEVIC prior to departure.
